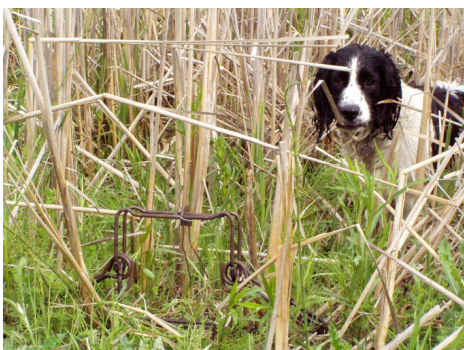


Petition to Protect Dogs

Problem: lethal trapping and snaring is killing Minnesota dogs.



- At least 50 dogs have been killed in body grip traps in Minnesota.
- Current trapping regulations don't protect Minnesota dogs.
- Dogs are killed on both public and private land, in road ditches, woods, wetlands, and fields.

Solution: 1) raise body-grip traps 5 feet off the ground, or 2) put them in boxes that exclude dogs, or 3) set them underwater. 4) Only non-lethal "cable restraint" snares on land are safe for dogs.

Tens of thousands of responsible trappers in Minnesota, neighboring states, and Canada successfully use these methods, without affecting harvest and without killing dogs.
